The foregoing, having been considered by the Court, is hereby:

ORDER: GRANTED

On February 8, 2022, this court issued an order authorizing the plaintiff to take the deposition of the keeper of records for DCF only accessing records pertaining to the plaintiff in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes section 17a-28(g)(1).

Records were produced by DCF but plaintiff's counsel was told any unauthorized disclosure of said records would subject counsel to fines and possible imprisonment. The records were produced in connection with a deposition notice and subpoena. Practice Book §§ 13-26 through 13-32 govern deposition practice in Connecticut. Under the Practice Book rules governing depositions, documents produced for inspection during the examination may be inspected and copied by any party, Practice Book § 13-30(f). Accordingly, plaintiff's counsel is authorized by the rules of practice and this court to provide copies of the records received from DCF to all counsel of record. However, in accordance with this court's previous ruling sealing court records in this case, see docket entry 124 and 124.10, all counsel shall keep such records confidential until further order of the court.
