On May 28, 2026, at 5:08 PM, Defendant's counsel further advised Plaintiff that, should Plaintiff proceed with noticing the deposition, counsel intends to seek a protective order. No such order has been entered.

In light of Defendant's refusal to provide available dates and the resulting delay in discovery, Plaintiff requests that the Clerk issue the subpoena so that the deposition may proceed as scheduled and discovery may move forward in an orderly manner.

Plaintiff has made good-faith efforts to schedule this deposition without court intervention. Those efforts have been unsuccessful due to Defendant's refusal to provide available dates, leaving issuance of the subpoena as the only practical means of moving discovery forward.

Plaintiff further requests that the Clerk hold the issued subpoena in its office for pickup.
