The following order is entered in the above matter:

ORDER:

After a hearing the court declines to alter its previous ruling denying the plaintiff's application to subpoena Christopher Bruce Goodrich and Rebecca Mayo Goodrich.

The plaintiff shall make himself available for a deposition in this case within the next 30 days. Failure to submit to a deposition within the next 30 days may result in the court imposing sanctions up to and including dismissal of this matter.

The court will take up the defendant's motion for protective order and the manner in which Noah Milot, Hannah Milot and Cameron Milot will be deposed, the location of said depositions, dates and times during the remote hearing on the motion for protective order.

To the extent the plaintiff seeks to depose Ms. Jowdy in this matter he shall contact and work with defense counsel and Ms. Jowdy's counsel in LLI CV 22-5014373 (Jowdy, Christine M. v. Milot, Jr., Raymond J.) to coordinate said deposition.

Fact witness discovery is extended to July 10, 2026.
